Additional School Funding/Free School Meals

Next week is an important week in the school calendar as the October School Census determines our school funding for the next financial year. With this in mind we are keen to have as many families as possible to apply for Free School Meals. A letter was sent out last week and a further copy accompanies this newsletter. Even if you do not think you are currently eligible it could still be useful to apply as your details are then regularly checked and should your circumstances change you will get immediate eligibility. We can also apply on your behalf so if you have limited IT access or skills please just complete the form and return to the school office. Every child eligible for Free School Meals brings significant additional funding to our school.
